# **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Mike Liston expressed appreciation for being considered for the CIB Designee position on the OUBCC Board. He said he was honored and flattered that the Board considered him for the position, but after discussion with his wife he decided that he could not accept the appointment.

Charles Snyder addressed the Board. Mr. Snyder stated he is an inactive unlimited building inspector and a licensed professional engineer. Mr. Snyder had concerns about the proposed rules for OAC 158:60 related to Authorized Agents. He believed that once the rules are effective, some municipalities are planning to use Authorized Agents for all residential inspections and treating them much like one would a subcontractor where the Authorized Agent would be paid directly by the contractor. Mr. Snyder believed that goes against the meaning and intent of the proposed rules. Mr. Snyder felt the proposed rules should include strong language to ensure that an Authorized Agent is not under contract with the contractor and is not receiving direct payment from the contractor as that would be a conflict of interest.

Jim Bullington, who recently retired from CareerTech, addressed the Board. Mr. Bullington introduced Ric Russell as the "new Jim." He stated Mr. Russell has been an HVAC instructor for about 20 years and will be working on the SkillsUSA program and will be CareerTech's liaison with the CIB field staff.

Ms. Hubbard and Mr. Kirk discussed the request from CareerTech that led to the proposed amendments and the expectation that it could help grow the industry by increasing examination pass rates and streamlining apprentice employment. They also discussed the requirements for having a registration as an endorsed apprentice and the requirements an endorsed apprentice would have to meet to later receive a license as a journeyman.
